## **Castaic Education Foundation Project Proposal Selection Criteria**

### **Project Summary:** The goal of the project: (25 points maximum)

- Provides a detailed description of the proposed project.
- Provides an impartial statement that will outline overall goals.
- Provides information describing what is unique and innovative about the proposed project.
- Describes research or needs analysis as a basis for the project.
- Links project to school or district goals.

### **Objectives of the Project** (25 points maximum)

- Describes objectives and specific activities.
- Describes how student content standards will be addressed by the project.
- Describes how project will enhance existing programs.
- Describes how project will facilitate collaboration among teachers.
- Includes information about how the success of the project will be measured.

### **Benefits of the Project** (25 Points maximum)

- Explains who is impacted by the project.
- Describes what subject areas and or student skills are improved.
- Explains when the project will be implemented and what the longevity is expected to be.
- Describes a process for evaluating the effectiveness of the project over time.
- Includes information or indicates that consumable supplies are not included in the project.

### **Potential of the Project:** (25 points maximum)

- Describes how the project impacts families, the community and other schools.
- Demonstrates that the project is easily replicated.
- Demonstrates how the project can be easily shared.
- Describes the long-term benefit of the project to a wide variety of students.
- Links potential of the project to student academic achievement.
